| City of Selkirk    | Wastewater system upgrades, including new lift station and forcemain.  | \$2,000,000                  |
| RM of St. Clements | East Selkirk water plant upgrade to membrane softening, which will improve water quality and eliminate all in-house treatment equipment.   | \$1,000,000                  |
| Town of Carman     | New water supply reservoir connected to Pembina Valley Water Co-op to replace aging water treatment plant, which does not meet current regulations. Trihalomethanes (THMs) and disinfection do not meet regulations. | \$3,500,000                  |
| RM of Ritchot      | Regional water supply upgrades at Ste. Agathe, St. Adolphe and Iles des Chenes to meet increased water demands due to population growth.   | \$2,500,000                  |
| City of Morden     | Water and wastewater system upgrades, including water distribution renewal and sewer relining.   | \$1,500,000                  |
| City of Winkler    | Wastewater system upgrades, including sewermain relining and lift station upgrade.   | \$1,500,000                  |
| RM of Argyle       | Water supply system upgrades and new groundwater source to deal with high nitrate levels. Glenora aquifer will be investigated for well site.  | \$500,000                    |
| RM of De Salaberry | Water distribution and wastewater collection upgrades in St. Malo.   | \$500,000                    |
| Town of Virden     | New forcemain and lift station.  | \$1,000,000                  |
| RM of McCreary     | Water supply system upgrades including new water metering system and watermain renewal.  | \$500,000                    |
| Town of Neepawa    | New water reservoir and distribution system upgrades to meet increased water demands due to growth with hog processing plant.  | \$3,000,000                  |
| Town of Neepawa    | Phase 1 wastewater lagoon upgrading design and aeration building.  | \$1,500,000                  |

| RM of Prairie View           | Community of Birtle requires a new water treatment plant to comply with current regulations.   | \$2,000,000 |
| City of Portage la Prairie   | Water and wastewater system upgrades include watermain renewal, new industrial park forcemain, as well as Phase 1 water treatment plant upgrading design drawings/tender documents. Water treatment plant produces THMs exceeding regulations. | \$3,000,000 |
| RM of Portage la Prairie     | Rural water pipeline infrastructure upgrades.  | \$350,000   |
| RM of St. Andrews            | Phase 2 forcemain and lift station required to continue developing the regional wastewater system with West St. Paul.  | \$4,000,000 |
| City of Brandon              | Water and wastewater collection upgrades, lift stations and water distribution model.  | \$2,000,000 |
| RM of Rockwood               | Radio frequency water metering system for the Community of Stony Mountain will replace old meters, increase revenue and lower administration costs.  | \$300,000   |
| Town of Stonewall            | New lift station and forcemain to wastewater lagoon to increase pumping capacity due to growth.  | \$1,000,000 |
| Town of Niverville           | New groundwater well field and pipeline to meet increasing water demand in the Town.   | \$1,250,000 |
| Cartier Regional Water Co-op | New raw water storage pond at St. Eustache water plant and reservoir/pumphouse at Elie to meet increasing water demand.  | \$2,500,000 |
