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**MANITOBA'S CLINICAL AND PREVENTATIVE SERVICES PLAN**

The Provincial Clinical and Preventive Services Plan will include:

- defined and patient-centred models of care and clinical pathways that will be easier for patients to navigate as they access care;
- integrated support services, including diagnostics, patient transport and emergency medical services;
- identified requirements for infrastructure, equipment and technology capital needs;
- clearly defined provider roles and innovative staffing models/integrated teams;
- clear service standards with target service levels; and
- defined, measurable outcomes and indicators to demonstrate success.

Provincial clinical teams will develop practical solutions within their individual specialty areas to identify interdependencies and address areas of potential conflict before recommendations are integrated across areas of focus. Teams are organized by specialty areas including:

- cancer and palliative care;
- cardiovascular and thoracic medicine;
- chronic care and complex medicine;
- emergency, critical care and acute medicine;
- neurosciences, mental health and addictions;
- women's health and child health;
- primary health and community services;
- seniors and rehabilitation;
- surgery and anesthesia; and
- trauma services.
