

**CHANGES TO PUBLIC HEALTH ORDERS EFFECTIVE  
WEDNESDAY, APRIL 28, 2021**

Private Residences	All households limited to two designated visitors.	No visitors allowed in either indoor or outdoor spaces except for specific exemptions including one visitor for people who live alone.
Indoor Gatherings	Up to five people.	No indoor gatherings permitted.
Outdoor Gatherings	Outdoor gatherings on public and private property limited to a maximum of 10 people including household members.	Outdoor gatherings on public property limited to a maximum of 10 people including household members. No outdoor gatherings are permitted on private property.
Restaurants and Bars	Dine-in with households only at 50 per cent capacity; patio dining with up to six people with no household restrictions, with other public health measures in effect.	No change to dine-in restrictions; patio dining limited to four people with no household restriction with other public health measures in effect; food courts in malls and shopping centres required to close.
Gyms and Fitness Centres	Capacity limit of 25 per cent with public health measures in place including for spectators and in common areas and locker rooms. Masks must be worn at all times except while swimming.	Capacity limit of 25 per cent with public health measures in place including for spectators and in common areas and locker rooms. Masks must be worn at all times except while swimming. Three metres of physical distancing is required at all times.
Casinos and VLTs	Casinos must remain closed; VLTs in a business may operate if each machine is separated by at least two metres of distance or by a non-permeable barrier.	No change.

Museums, Galleries and Libraries	Capacity limit of 25 per cent or up to 250 people, whichever is lower.	No change.
Movies Theatres and Concert Halls	Must remain closed.	No change.
Weddings and Funerals	Up to 10 people plus photographer/officiants.	No change.
Community, Cultural and Religious Gatherings	Capacity limit of 25 per cent or 50 people, whichever is lower. Masks are not required when seated when appropriately distanced and when not singing or chanting.	Capacity limit of 25 per cent capacity up to 10 people, whichever is lower. Mask use required at all times.
Drive-in Services/Events	Permitted.	No change.
Personal Services	Open at 50 per cent capacity.	No change to capacity, but an appointment must be made to access services.
Indoor Sports and Recreation	Individual play and team practices permitted, no games, 10-person group limit, 25 per cent capacity in off-play areas.	No change to activity permitted. Further limits include no more than one observer/spectator per youth participant and spectators must maintain two metres distance.
Outdoor Sports and Recreation	Games allowed, spectators governed by gathering rules.	No change to activity permitted. Further limits include no more than one observer/spectator per youth participant and spectators must maintain two metres distance.
Dance, theatre and music schools	25 per cent capacity.	25 per cent capacity to a maximum of 10, spectators limited to one per youth participant and spectators must maintain two metres distance.
Day camps	Up to 25 children permitted.	Up to 10 children permitted indoors and outdoors.
Retail and Malls	Open at 33 per cent capacity up to a maximum of 333 persons. Mall capacity limit of up to 33 per cent of the facility's capacity.	Open at 25 per cent capacity up to a maximum of 250 people. Mall capacity limit of up to 25 per cent of the facility's capacity.
