WINNIPEG MAN NAMED TO PUBLIC UTILITIES BOARD

Donovan N. Knight, a Winnipeg businessman, has been appointed to fill a vacancy on the Public Utilities Board, Consumer and Corporate Affairs Minister John B. Carroll has announced.

Mr. Knight has been associated with the financial life of western Canada since 1922. He served with Wood Gundy Securities Ltd. for 42 years, retiring as a director of the company in 1965. He is a past chairman of the Investment Dealers Association, Manitoba and Saskatchewan district, and of the Community Welfare Planning Council. Since January, 1968, he has been a member of the Targets for Economic Development (TED) Commission for Manitoba.

He will assume his duties with the Public Utilities Board immediately.

Chairman of the board is D. Murray Peden, Q.C. Other members are D.E. Mathewson, vice-chairman, of Winnipeg; H. DeLeeuw, of St. Boniface and A.R. Swanson, of Winnipeg.
