New Chairman
Is Al Chisvin

Attorney General Roland Penner has announced the appointment of Al Chisvin, a Winnipeg chartered accountant, as chairman of the Manitoba Liquor Control Commission. He succeeds Alexander Bruce Tevendale.

Mr. Penner also announced the appointment of Florence Matthews as vice-chairwoman, succeeding Laurence Pollard and Jack S. Parkin as the board's third member, succeeding Mary Prokopowich.

Mr. Chisvin was formerly vice-chairman of the Manitoba Public Insurance Corporation and chairman of the Manitoba Rent Stabilization Board. Ms. Matthews practised law in Swan River before becoming a crown attorney and, more recently, a provincial court judge for the Dauphin judicial district. She has resided in Winnipeg since 1978. Mr. Parkin, now retired was employed with the Liquor Control Commission for nearly 40 years.

Among other duties, the commission is charged with exercising general control, management and supervision over all liquor stores in the province.
